


How to access and use the online catalogue of the “Hengeler Mueller-Library” of Bucerius Law School


1. Go to the online catalogue of the “Hengeler Mueller Library” of Bucerius Law School
<http://vzopc4.gbv.de:8080/DB=9/SET=3/TTL=6/LNG=EN/>
2. Enter the book title, author, publication, etc. into the search field.


3. You can refine your search to optimize the results by using certain keywords. Click on the question mark next to the search field for explanations on the different categories.

4. For example, when looking for the book "Brealey / Myers / Allen, 2011 (10th ed.), Corporate Finance, McGraw-Hill, Chapter 31: Mergers" enter one of the authors names into the field and click on search.

Online-Catalogue of the "Hengeler Mueller Library" Bucerius Law School




