

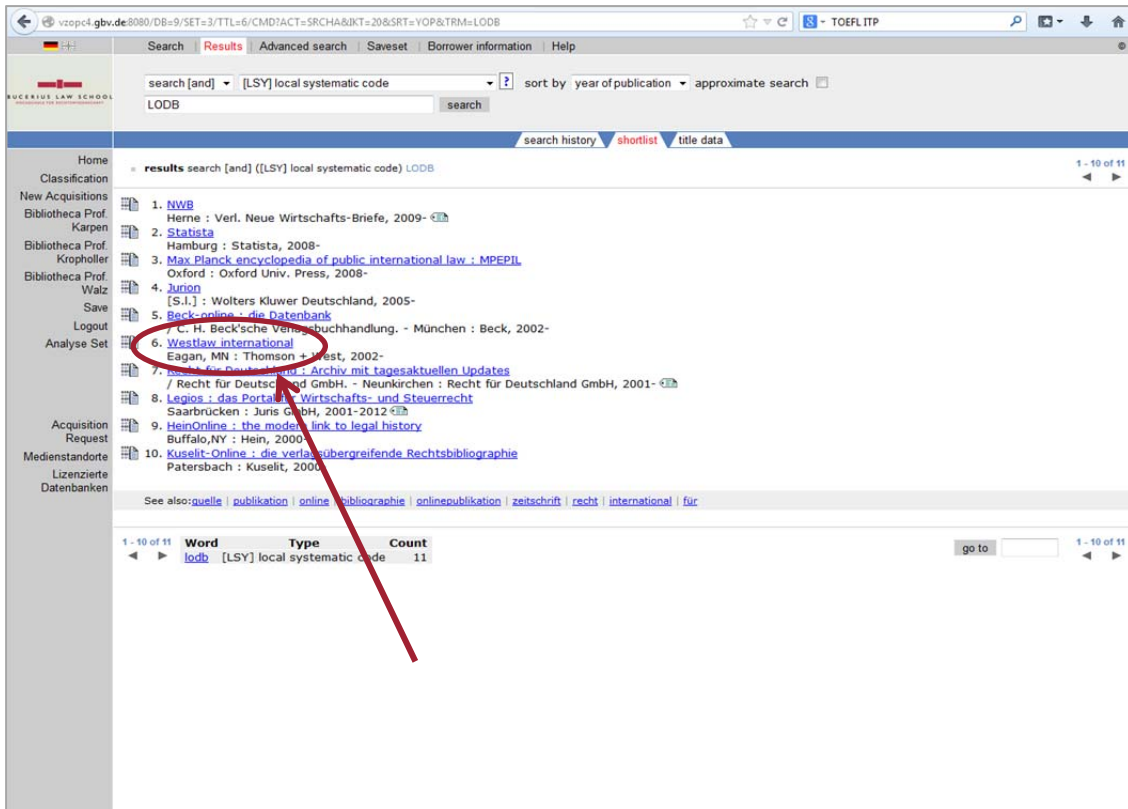
How to access and use the Westlaw Database

1. Go to the online catalogue of the "Hengeler Mueller Library" of Bucerius Law School

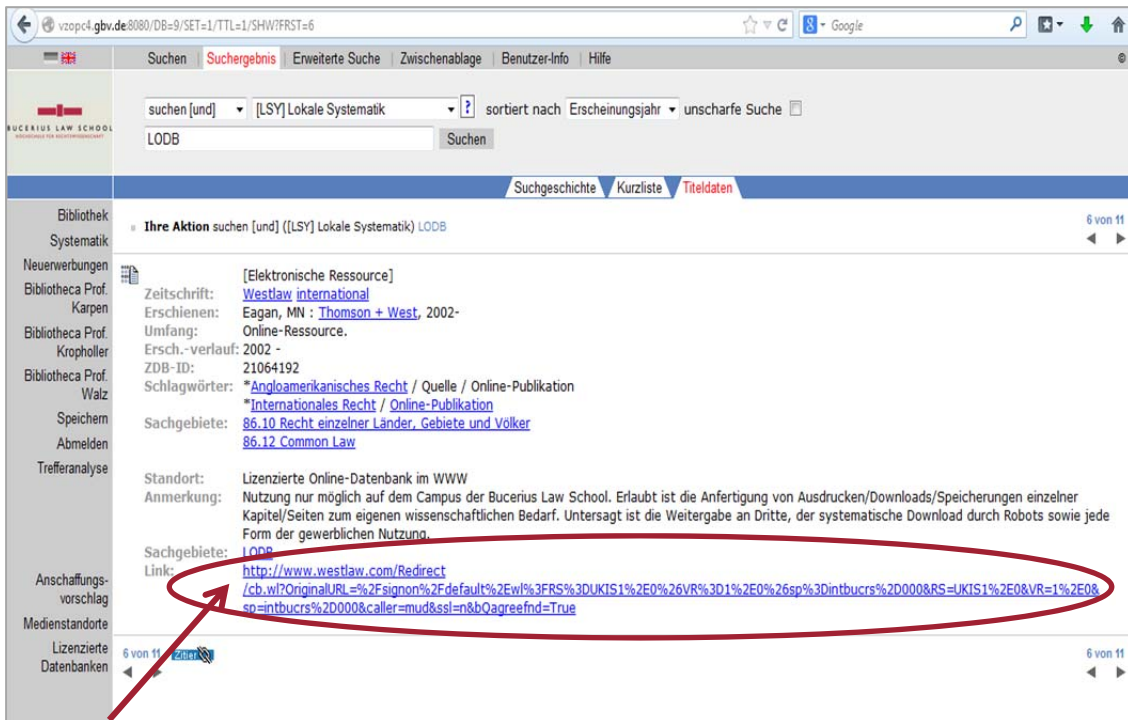

4. Click on Westlaw International

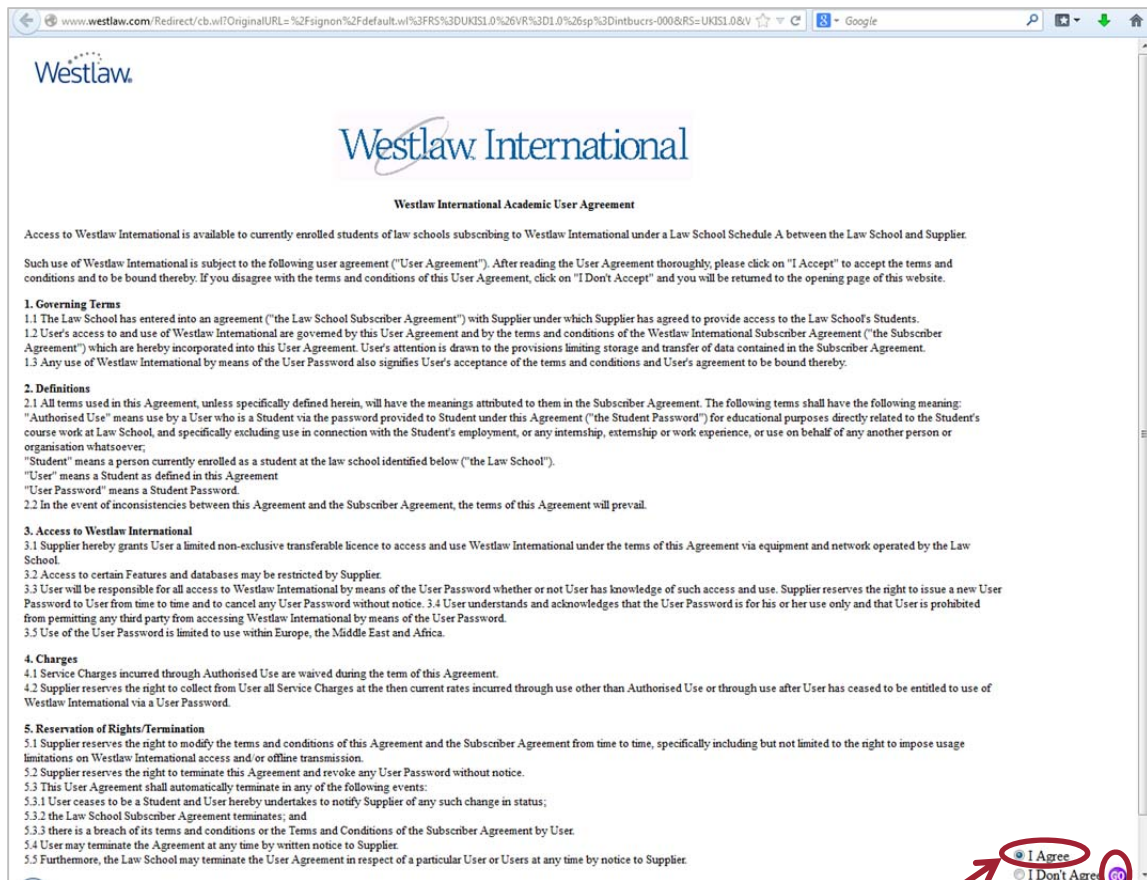


5. You will then be forwarded to a site containing short information about the website, in this case Westlaw

6. Click on the link which will forward you to the Westlaw database

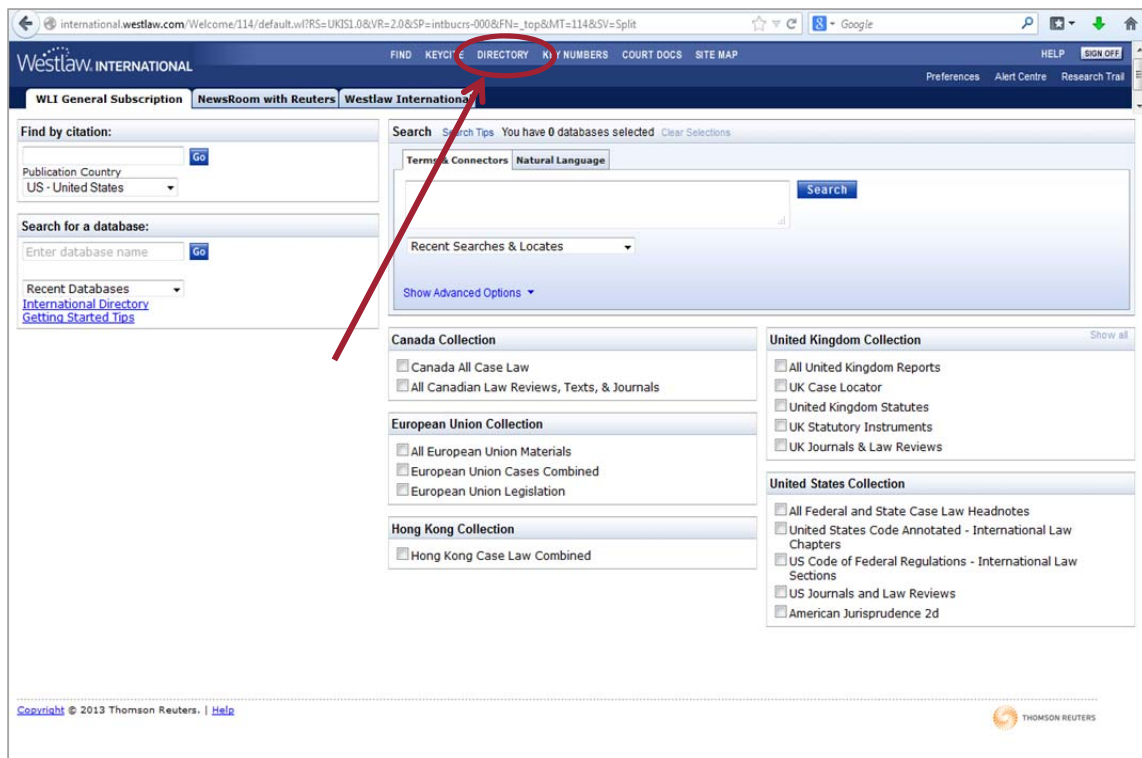


7. Click on "I agree" and "Go" in order to agree to Westlaw's Academic User Agreement




8. You will be forwarded to Westlaw International

9. Click on "Directory"




10. Click on "Legal Periodicals & Current Awareness" ...



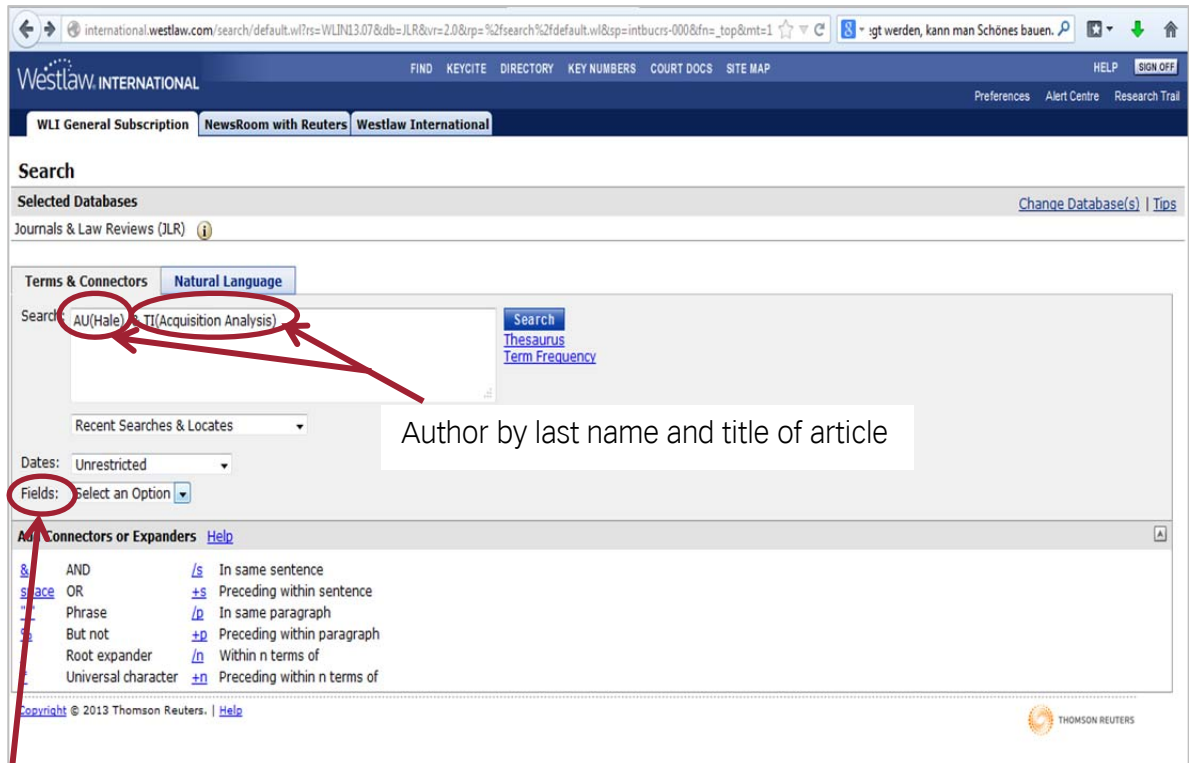

11. ... and then either click on "Journals and Law Reviews" or "World Journals and Law Reviews"



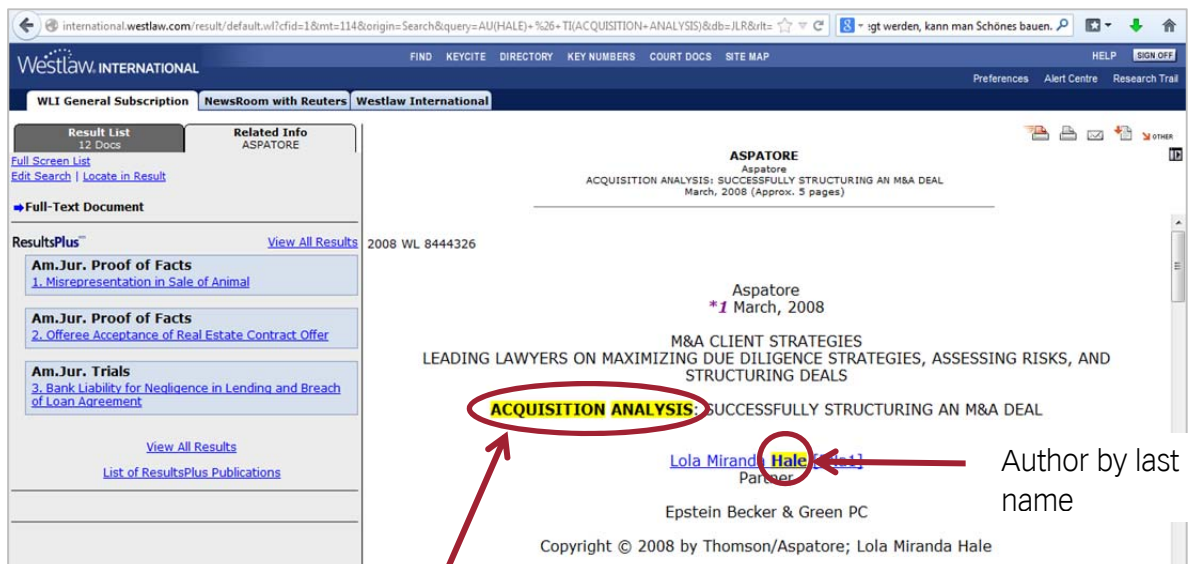

12. You can then search the documents via author, title, source, etc. by choosing a field option under "Fields" (for example "Acquisition Analysis" by Lola Miranda Hale). Then click on "Search"
